



PATIENT VISIT GUIDELINES

- 1) We are asking that our patients monitor their health and, if they experience signs or symptoms of the flu or coronavirus (COVID-19), they refrain from visiting the clinic until symptoms have resolved. For the SAFETY of our patients and our staff we are not currently able to see anyone that has a recent onset of **Fever, Cough or Shortness of Breath or have been in contact with anyone experiencing these symptoms.**
- 2) United Wellness is carefully monitoring all staff. Any employee that is coughing or has had direct contact with a COVID-19 patient will be put on 14-day quarantine.
- 3) To be able to enter United Wellness and attend your appointment, we will be requiring a face mask or covering at all times while in the office, please be prepared with this ahead of time as we do not have a surplus inventory to provide you with one at this time. **WE WILL ALSO TAKE YOUR TEMPERATURE AS YOU ARRIVE.** Anyone with a fever of 100.4 and higher will be advised to visit their physician or urgent care for further assessment prior to being seen in our office. No one with a fever of 100.4 or higher will be seen in our offices at this time.
- 4) During this important time, we are asking our patients to not bring guests with them into their appointment due to social distancing requirements and we will require them to wait in the vehicle for you.

However, there are 2 exceptions to this requirement

- a. A minor with a one (1) parent or guardian (facial covers are required for both)
 - b. A patient requiring physical assistance, due to disability or injury one (1) person (facial covers are required for both)
- 5) While in United Wellness, patients are asked to abide by well-documented CDC safety precautions such as using hand sanitizer or hand washing, avoid touching you face after contacting surfaces, and sneeze or cough into your elbows, instead of your hands.
 - 6) United Wellness & Sports Rehab will continue to ensure our equipment, and the environment we provide, is as clean as our patients expect.

We have increased our cleaning routines for commonly touched areas, and we are wiping down all equipment, adjusting tables and as always, replacing facial paper on the adjusting table head piece after each patient.
